128. **UPDATE SPEED INDICATOR DEVICES (SID), GAGINGWELL**

- A resident in Gagingwell had contacted the clerk, concerned about the position of the post at the western end of Gagingwell. A quote of £354.60 has been received for relocating the post. After discussion it was agreed that Cllrs. Parker and Ward will undertake a site visit, under Covid regulations, to ascertain the best position for the SID and then speak to the resident concerned. Cllr. Shaw will contact Wescotec, requesting information on when the SIDs will be installed.
